PURE AND PART BRED ARABS

- 34** Best In Hand Pure Bred Arab/Anglo Arab or Part Bred Arab – any age (*class will be split into 4 years and over and 3 years and under if more than 8 entries forward on the day*).
- 35** Best Ridden Pure, Anglo or Part Bred Arab - Four years old or over.

Veteran Horse Society – AREA QUALIFIER 2024.

First round qualifier for the Veteran Horse Society Supreme Championships

Final: VETERAN HORSE OF THE YEAR 2024 -Kindly Sponsored by Allen & Page.

Open to members and non-members. All competitors and grooms must adhere to VHS Rules in all circumstances. Failure to do so may result in immediate disqualification. VHS Regional Final qualification. All competitors placed 1st to 4th in each age category will qualify for the corresponding class at VHS Regional Finals. Members must carry their cards in the ring and have their showing card signed by the judge in the ring as proof of qualification. Non-members will receive a red qualification card which can be exchanged for signed showing card when applying for VHS membership. This MUST be done within 21 days of qualification. It is the competitors responsibility to present their Showing card to the judge. Regional Finals are open to members only.

All competitors are eligible to enter open classes at the National Veteran Championships, to be held at Arena UK Lincolnshire on 30th August-1st September 2024. No qualification or membership necessary. See VHS website for schedule which is available mid-season 2024.

VHS VETERAN IN-HAND, COMBINED AGE CLASS (15 years and over). To be run as one class but judged as separate age categories: Diamond Veteran (25 years and over), Veteran (20–24 years) & Pre-Veteran (15–19 years). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height.

CHILDREN’S RIDING/YOUNG HANDLER (Unaffiliated)

- 38 Best Turned Out Horse or Pony and Rider** - Mare or Gelding, four years old or over to be ridden. Rider 18 years and under.
- 39 Novice Pony** – SP/SHP /WHP - not exceeding 14.2hh, never to have won a first prize in a ridden class, rider any age.

- 40 **Best Leading Rein.** Show Hunter or Show Pony - Mare or Gelding, four years old or over, not exceeding 12hh (122cms), suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained their 9th birthday on the 1st January the current year.
- 41 **Best First Ridden. Show Hunter or Show Pony** - Mare or Gelding, four years old or over, not exceeding 12hh (122cms), suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained their 11th birthday on the 1st January in the current year.
- 42 **Mixed Height Open Show Pony/Open Show Hunter** - Mare or gelding, four years old or over suitable to be ridden by a child. Not exceeding 12.2hh rider not having attained their 13th birthday, not exceeding 13.2 rider not having attained their 15th birthday and not exceeding 14.2hh rider not having attained their 17th birthday on 1st January in the current year.
- 43 **Best Young Handler** - six to ten years of age on the day of the show. **Entry fee per exhibit per class is £1. No stallions or colts permitted.**
- 44 **Best Young Handler** - eleven to sixteen years of age on the day of the show. **Entry fee per exhibit per class is £1. No stallions or colts permitted.**

CHAMPIONSHIP - First and Second Prize winners from classes 38 to 44 eligible to compete.

SHETLANDS

- 45 **Best in hand Shetland** - any age (*class will be split into 4 and over and 3 and under if more than 8 entries forward on the day*)
- 46 **Best ridden Shetland** - Four years old or over (lead reins permitted).

CHAMPIONSHIP - First and Second prize winners from classes 45 and 46 eligible to compete.

MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND

- 47 **Mountain and Moorland in hand** - Youngstock -colt, filly or gelding, three year old or under.
- 48 **Mountain and Moorland in hand** - stallion, mare or gelding, four years old or over.
- 49 **Mountain and Moorland Ridden** (small breeds) - stallions, mares or geldings, four years old or over. Breeds eligible for this class are Section A and B, Shetland, Dartmoor, New Forest, Exmoor. No pony may be led in this class.
- 50 **Mountain and Moorland Ridden** (large breeds) - stallions, mares or geldings, four years old or over. Breeds eligible for this class are Section C, D, Connemara, New Forest, Dales, Fells and Highlands.

CHAMPIONSHIP - First and Second Prize winners from classes 47 to 50 are eligible to compete.

Mountain and Moorland Mini Pony

- 51 Mountain and Moorland Leading Rein** - Mare or gelding, four years old or over, not exceeding 12hh, suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- 52 Mountain and Moorland First Ridden** - Mare or gelding, four years old or over, not exceeding 12.2hh, suitable for and to be ridden by a child not having attained their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. No pony may be led in this class.

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP - First and Second Prize winners from classes 51 to 52 are eligible to compete.

This Show is affiliated to The Rescue Equine Showing Society final taking place at the Equifest, Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire.

As Llanedi show is being held after Equifest 2024, these classes will qualify for 2025 Final.

The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified will qualify for the Rescue Equine Society Final

53 OPEN IN HAND Open in Hand: Any age, type, breed. Mares with foal at foot are not permitted. No exhibit under the age of one year may be exhibited on its own.

54 OPEN RIDDEN Open Ridden: Any type or breed, four years of age and over. Can include Lead Rein and First Ridden (will not be included in the initial go-round). All riders must be the appropriate height / weight for their equine.

CHAMPIONSHIP First and second Prize winner from Classes 53 and 54

Definition of Rescue

1. Any equine that is adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any National Equine Welfare Council registered Charity (NEWC).
2. Any equine that has been adopted, fostered, under a guardianship scheme from any other equine charity (must be registered with the Charity Commission).
3. Any equine that has been 'independently' rescued by an individual. There must be supporting evidence (photographic, veterinary) that will be included in the 'Rescue History' for the equine, to demonstrate their rescue status.

Mark System: The mark system is designed to reward those equines that have the strongest rescue history. The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP - To be competed for by the Champion exhibit in each section. The Royal Oak Cup to be presented to the supreme champion of show together with £50 prize money. The Reserve Supreme Champion will receive £20 prize money.

PRIZES – Each Section Champion will receive £20 and Reserve £10 (however each section to have at least 6 entries within the section)
